QUALIFYING CRITERIA FOR THE INDIAN NATIONAL FINALS RODEO HALL OF FAME

NOMINATIONS FOR INDUCTION

- a) Any Indian Cowboy or Cowgirl will become eligible after the age of 50 or deceased.
- b) Any Indian Cowboy or Cowgirl actively engaged in Indian Rodeo through the Indian National Finals Rodeo (INFR) for a period of at least 10 years, with distinguished performance over that time.
- c) Any Livestock (roughstock, rope or barrel horse) that has actively competed in INFR rodeos for 5 years or more.
- d) Nominators must give a brief biography of the candidate's/livestock's life including things they achieved in and out of the arena. All credentials should include all things related to rodeo, plus other achievements in regard to their western way of life.
